The new manufacturing facilities are now consolidated under one roof in Carlsbad, CA, site of the company's corporate headquarters. "We have focused on building a core inventory that delivers same day shipments in a broad parameter range of +4 to -8 in the *SynergEyes® A* product, as well as expedited turnaround on made-to-order and custom lenses".

SynergEyes manufactures a new type of contact lens that combines two materials – a rigid gas permeable center and a soft, hydrophilic outer skirt. The result is a durable "hybrid" lens for patients seeking crisp, clear vision with the comfort of a soft lens.

Incorporating patented HyperBond™ technology and HydrolEyes™ surface science, the SynergEyes lenses with FDA market clearance include *SynergEyes® A* for naturally occurring ametropia, targeting patients with astigmatism, current gas permeable lens wearers, and patients demanding optimized vision; the *SynergEyes® KC* for keratoconus, the *SynergEyes® M* lens for presbyopia and *SynergEyes® PS* for post surgery and post trauma refractive errors.
